

## COLLECTION HIGHLIGHTS AT SEACITY MUSEUM

### CAPTAIN SMITH'S SWORD

Captain Smith perished with the Titanic. His Royal Naval Reserve sword, donated by his family in 1912 now features in SeaCity Museum in the Southampton's Titanic Story exhibition.



### POCKET WATCH

The pocket watch of Titanic Steward Sidney Sedunary is also featured in SeaCity Museum. It stopped at 10 minutes to 2, shortly before the Titanic sank. A few days later, the watch and other of Sidney's possessions were recovered from his body by the crew of the ship Mackay Bennett.



### QUEEN MARY MODEL

This large-scale model of the Queen Mary ship weighs over one tonne and is seven metres in length. It was the first object to arrive at SeaCity Museum when it moved from Southampton's former Maritime Museum to its new permanent home.
