## Southampton's Titanic Story

After lunch you will visit the Southampton's Titanic Story gallery.



The gallery can sometimes be busy and noisy.

Inside the gallery you will see a street scene.

It is quite dark and has sound effects.



You will see a room with lots of flaps to open and things to look at.



There are lots of interactive parts of the gallery.

You can try steering Titanic.



You can try keeping Titanic's engine's running.



You can practise Morse code.



Some rooms in the gallery are quite dark with bright screens and sound effects.





After you have been through the gallery you will pick up your coats and bags from your trolley.

### Toilets

If you need the toilet while you are in the museum, there are toilets upstairs in the main hall.



There also toilets downstairs. The accessible toilet is downstairs.
