

YOU can still come to us in person. We're being extra careful at all our venues to ensure all our visitors are safe. A designated member of staff will be on hand to look after you throughout your visit and you'll have a private large classroom space away from our public areas. Prices from £47 per class. 
History and art outreach sessions are risk assessed in line with your school's COVID safety measures. We have enough equipment to support year groups bubbling as individual classes.



ART ON WHEELS

Southampton City Art Gallery comes to your school! Inspiring works of art have been hand-picked by our curators from our outstanding collection, including: a Picasso print, paintings and drawings by Ian Hamilton Finlay, Paul Nash, Southampton-born Eric Meadus, and many more.

You get to choose an artwork from our list of themes then tell us what kind of art workshop you'd like. We'll bring the artwork to your classroom then lead a discussion and a practical workshop inspired by the artwork you have chosen.



INTERACTIVE ASSEMBLIES

Whole year-group history assemblies are a fantastic 'hook' for your history topic to educate, entertain and enthuse your students!

It couldn't be simpler: a member of the museums learning team will come to you with objects, props and costumes to introduce your year group to the history topic you have chosen.

Our whole-year assemblies last between 45 minutes and an hour and are chocked full of games, stories and other interactive elements.



HISTORY BROUGHT TO LIFE IN YOUR CLASSROOM

Session

Description

Ancient Egyptians



Take part in the weighing-of-the-heart ceremony, find out how the Egyptians mummified their dead and have a look at some of the objects from the museums collection. This session is designed to be led in an assembly-style and is great as an introduction to the topic!

Prehistory



Find out about the people who called Southampton home thousands of years ago! Handle objects, dress as a cave man and discover why people threw brand new swords away!

The Romans



Visit Clausentum, Roman Southampton, in this immersive session including genuine artefacts, some dressing up and fun hands-on activities!

Settlers & Invaders



Meet the Anglo-Saxons and Vikings in this fun introductory session. Uncover our mystery object, dress as a Viking warrior and try your hand at weaving the Anglo-Saxon way.

The Tudors



Find out what life was like 500 years ago. Handle genuine objects from the period, find out about the food eaten by the king and discover more about the dreaded plague!

Titanic: Crew Required



A brilliant supplement to a visit to our sister museum SeaCity Museum, this session explores what life would have been like for the crew on the ship. Discover more about the impact the sinking had on the people of Southampton. **Classroom only.**

Second World War



An immersive session looking at the Second World War in a sensitive way. Handle real objects from the time, dress as an ARP Warden and imagine what life would have been like for an evacuee.

Toys Through Time



A whistle-stop tour through the toys children played with in the past. Try our toy timeline, master quoits and have a go at blind drawing our mystery toys!

Great Fire of London



Join us for an incredible hands-on session discovering the story of the Great Fire of London. Take part in a selection of fun interactive activities including our 'Great Fire Finds Dig', sights and smells game and a chance to meet the person responsible for the fire!

New Online Learning



VIRTUAL SESSIONS: Online, interactive, curriculum-based lessons



Our online sessions last for an hour, with the option to extend this for a longer practical art workshop and can be tailored to meet the needs of your children. ONLINE HISTORY SESSIONS

Titanic, The Tudors, The Stuarts, The Anglo-Saxons, Romans, Pre-history, World War Two, Toys Through Time, The Great Fire of London, Dinosaurs and Pirates.

Our virtual history workshop combines several different activities to engage learners and bring history to life. Workshops are interactive, with a good pace of activities throughout the session. During the sessions participants will discover stories, have an in-depth look at objects and costumes and have a chance to ask questions to our history expert.



EXPLORE AND CREATE: Virtual Art Sessions inspired by Southampton City Art Gallery:

Art-based workshops will take between one and two hours, with built in breaks as necessary. Each of our art workshops can include:

- A pre-recorded virtual gallery tour with the focus of your choice (**For example: Portraits / Landscape / Art Movements**)
- Q&A time following the tour.
- Accessible paper-based art activities using readily available classroom resources and exercises. These are designed to develop new skills and empower children to engage with the artwork explored in virtual tour.
- The option of booking an additional in-depth practical artist led workshop

A FEW MORE DETAILS



WHAT ARE VIRTUAL SESSIONS?

Virtual Sessions are online, live, face-to-face workshops with a member of our learning team. We understand that schools and groups are teaching in new and creative ways: some may be in school physically while other students may be working remotely from home. We want you to know that our Virtual Sessions can be accessed by dialling-in from school, home, or a blending of both, so that **all of your students can learn together at the same time**. If this is not possible, don't worry, we will ensure all students are provided with an equivalent home learning experience via pre-recorded sessions and downloadable activity packs.

Virtual Sessions can be accessed through various different online platforms, including Zoom, Google Meet and Teams. If you normally use a different platform just let us know and we'll do our best to make it as straightforward for you as possible.

WHO ARE THEY FOR?

Our Virtual Sessions can work well for anyone with internet access, but they are particularly designed In school settings (both in class and remote-learning), for home educators, Special Educational Needs and lifelong learning groups like U3As (find out more about our online adult talks [here](#)).

WHAT ARE YOU DOING ABOUT SECURITY?

Your online safety is our top priority, so there are a number of ways that we can ensure that your children will remain safe online. Although different online platforms have different security features, all of our Virtual Sessions will include password protection and we request that schools start and host the meeting. In addition, we will never record meetings, will ensure that our educators are never alone with children or vulnerable adults and have a full Disclosure and Barring Service (DBS) clearance. Upon booking, you will also receive further details of what we're doing to keep you and your students safe.

HOW DO I BOOK?

1. Choose the session you'd like from the table below.
2. Contact us at museums.education@southampton.gov.uk. Our bookings officer Becky will help you through the booking stage and will be on-hand during office hours (Monday-Friday; 9am-5pm) to assist you with any questions or queries.
3. You will be sent a teacher's pack containing login details for your virtual session as well as our safeguarding guidelines. You will also receive access to our special online content so you can plan your lessons accordingly.
4. On the day of the session you will enjoy a fantastic online session at an agreed time and using an agreed platform. Should the technology not work for all of the participants you will not be charged for the session.

HOW MANY PEOPLE CAN JOIN A VIRTUAL SESSION?

During the current climate we want to work flexibly to support as many students as necessary. We'll be pleased to discuss this in more detail at your time of booking. If your school has five or more classes we advise splitting the sessions over a couple of days, just as you might with a visit to one of our venues.
